## Introduction

b) Reports on international or domestic scientific events or anniversaries;

c) Comprehensive reviews on topical subjects in a particular field of science;

d) Information on foreign scientific organizations and international relations in any particular field; Book reviews.

Papers shall be written in concise English. Contributors who are not native English speakers are advised to get their manuscript checked by a native English-speaking colleague prior to submission. Papers – including a short summary, tables, figures and list of references – should not exceed 16 pages (Margins: 5 cm upper, 5.5 cm lower, 4 cm left, 4.5 cm right; single space; Font type: Times New Roman (text 10.5 pt, tables and figure captions 9.5 pt). Lines should be numbered to facilitate the review process.

## Material and methods

For the sake of uniformity, papers of type a) should as far as possible conform to the following outline:

a) Abstract/Summary (at most one typed page, giving a concise description of the problem studied, the methods applied, the results achieved and the conclusions drawn from them). After the Summary, please define up to 5 keywords.

b) Introduction (grounds for the research, brief survey of literature);

c) Material and methods.

e) Discussion and conclusions

71 The construction of papers of type b) – d) will depend on the subject matter.

### 73 **Results**

74  
75 Experimental results can be presented either in tables or in figures, but the  
76 same data must not be included in both. *The number of tables and figures should*  
77 *not exceed 3–4.* Tables and figures should be inserted at the end of the manuscript.  
78 In case of large size, they can be submitted in a separate file. At the final layout,  
79 they will be placed in the correct position.

80 Each table must be numbered and supplied with a title. Care should be taken to  
81 ensure that dimensions are indicated accurately using internationally accepted units.

82 *Photographs and illustrations* (max. 3–4) should be marked “Figure” and  
83 numbered consecutively. Only photographs with good definition and contrast can  
84 be accepted. Diagrams should be clear and accurate. The title and legend of the  
85 figure should be included in the list of figures. The diagrams should contain as little  
86 text as possible; the various parts of compound figures should be designated with  
87 capital letters, and lower-case letters should be used within each figure (e.g. to  
88 distinguish individual curves). The explanation of these letters should be contained  
89 in the caption.

90 *The size of the tables and figures should not exceed 12.5 x 18.5 cm*  
91

### 92 **Discussion and Conclusion**

93  
94 The Editorial Board decides on the acceptance of the submitted papers based  
95 on the opinion of reviewers (min. two). The authors receive feedback from the  
96 reviewer on the form of review sheet. Reviewers can make corrections in the  
97 submitted article, if necessary. To correct bugs, shortcomings, or other comments  
98 indicated by the reviewers, please indicate clearly (e.g. write in red within the  
99 corrected text or mark it with yellow background). Regardless of the corrections  
100 made in the article, you should respond to the judgments in a separate file.

101 The author(s) will receive a camera-ready proof of the final-form articles that  
102 can be published. Please send it back with your corrections to the Editorial Board  
103 within 72 hours.

104 The author(s) is responsible for the content of the announcements. By  
105 submitting the manuscript, the author(s) will automatically declare that the  
106 manuscript submitted for publication in the AGROKÉMIA és TALAJTAN  
107 Editorial Office has not been published or submitted for publication in another  
108 journal. The author is obliged to submit a [Copyright](#) Transfer Statement with Green  
109 Open Access extension or can choose from the publisher’s [Open Access models](#).  
110 The submitted form should be sent to one of the contact details of the Editorial  
111 Board.

## References

A *list of references* should be included at the end of the paper, in alphabetical order of authors or editors. In the text, the author's Name should be given, followed by the year of publication in brackets (ALLEN, et al. 1998). If several articles published by a particular author in the same year are cited, these should be distinguished by lower-case letters written after the year. When compiling the list of references, the following guidelines should be adhered to:

- a) Name(s) of author(s), the year of publication, the titles of the work (in the original language, using phonetic transcription if not in roman letters) and the place of publication must be included.
- b) In the case of papers appearing in journals, the name(s) of the author(s), the year of publication, the title of the paper, the name of the journal, the volume number (in bold), in certain cases the issue number (in brackets) and the first and last page numbers of the paper must be included, e.g.  
Kilmer, V. I. & Alexander, L. T., 1949. Methods of making mechanical analysis of soils. *Soil Sci.* **14**. 485-499.
- c) In the case of books the reference should include the name(s) of the author(s) or editor(s), the year of publication, the title of the book, the publisher and the place of publication, e.g.:  
Hutchinson, C. S., 1974. *Laboratory Handbook of Petrographic Techniques*. Wiley. New York.  
Brown, G. (ed.), 1961. *The X-ray Identification and Crystal Structures of Clay Minerals*. Min. Soc. London.
- d) In the case of book sections, the name of the author of the section, the year of publication of the book, the title of the section and the data listed in point c) for the book must be supplied, e.g.:  
Day, P. R., 1965. Particle fractionation and particle-size analysis. In: *Methods of Soil Analysis*. (Ed.: Black, A. ) 110–127. Am. Soc. Agron. Madison, Wisc.
- e) Verbal communications need not be listed, while in the case of manuscripts, only the author, the year and the title need be designated.


