AIMS AND SCOPE

ARCHAEOLOGIAI ÉRTEŚÍTŐ focuses on the ancient peoples who lived on the territory of Hungary, in the Carpathian Basin and the archaeological heritage of the Hungarian people, offering at the same time a good overview of new directions in and new findings of Hungarian archaeology, as well as news of various conferences and new excavations. The journal also has a section that offers reviews of newly published Hungarian and foreign archaeological books that contributes to the flow of information about new directions in archaeology, about archaeology as a discipline and the role of this discipline in society. The languages of the journal are English and Hungarian.

EDITORIAL BOARD INFORMATION

THE ARCHAEOLOGIAI ÉRTEŚÍTŐ was founded by the Hungarian Academy of Sciences in 1868 and is still financially supported. Today, the publication is maintained by the Hungarian Archaeological and Art History Society. Its publisher is Akadémiai Kiadó, Budapest, Hungary.

SUBMISSION

REVIEW PROCESS

PREFERRED CONDITIONS OF MANUSCRIPTS

ARCHAEOLOGIAI ÉRTESÍTŐ strives to publish high quality papers. To ensure this goal, we apply some basic principles when reviewing a manuscript. Not fulfilling these principles may lead to desk rejection of a submitted manuscript.

REVIEW OF THE MANUSCRIPTS

Each paper will be read by at least one unbiased referee, chosen avoiding any conflict of interest. ARCHAEOLOGIAI ÉRTESÍTŐ applies a single blind review process, in which the reviewer's identity is not revealed to the authors, while the reviewer is aware of the authors' identity.

Unpublished results are treated strictly confidentially.

COPYRIGHT AND LICENCE POLICY

OPEN ACCESS

Authors of ARCHAEOLOGIAI ÉRTESÍTŐ can optionally choose Open Access appearance. With this choice, readers can read, download, copy, distribute, print, search or link to the full texts of articles, or use them for any other non-commercial lawful purpose. Such articles are distributed under Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial 4.0 International Licenses.

SELF-ARCHIVING

The Author is entitled to self-archive the preprint version of his/her manuscript. The preprint version is the Author's manuscript or the galley proof or the Author's manuscript along with the corrections made in the course of the peer review process. The Author's right to self-archive is irrespective of the format of the preprint (.doc, .txt, .pdf) version and self-archiving includes the free circulation of this file via email or publication of this preprint on the Author's webpage or on the Author's institutional repository with open or restricted access. When self-archiving a paper, the Author should clearly declare that the archived file is not the final published version of the paper, he/she should quote the correct citation and enclose a link to the published paper ([http://dx.doi.org/\[DOI of the Article without brackets\]](http://dx.doi.org/[DOI of the Article without brackets])).

AUTHOR CHARGES

PEER REVIEW CHARGE

No *submission fee* or *peer review charge* applies.

ARTICLE PROCESSING CHARGE

If choosing the optional Open Access appearance, corresponding author of every manuscript submitted after Feb 1, 2020 is requested to pay the *Article Processing Charge* (APC) of 900 EUR (including VAT) to cover the publishing costs of the paper.

In accordance with the agreement between the [Electronic Information Service National Programme](#) (EISZ) and Akadémiai Kiadó, papers with a corresponding author affiliated to a member institution subscribing to the journal package of Akadémiai Kiadó, can be published with no fee.

Akadémiai Kiadó offers 50% discount for Editorial Board members, and institutions of low- and middle-income countries. Discounts may not be combined. A limited number of waivers is available.

Manuscripts with outstanding payment will not be published until the balance is cleared. Once your paper is accepted for publication in *ARCHAEOLOGIAI ÉRTESÍTŐ*, and the authors made the Open Access choice, you will be requested to enter our online payment platform (<http://apc.akademiai.hu>), where after registration You can upload license agreement and transfer the fee. Article processing will commence after the amount due has been remitted to our account. (Please note that there is no peer review charge, the only applicable fee is the article processing charge for authors of accepted papers who made the OA choice.)

STRUCTURE OF THE MANUSCRIPT

Title of the paper, *name* of the author, *workplace*, *mailing address* of the workplace and *e-mail address*

Abstract: max 300 characters, in English and Hungarian

Keywords: max five terms in English and Hungarian

Hierarchy: titles of sections (chapters) are bold, titles of subsections are italic. Please do not use numerals.

Image reference: in parentheses at the end of the sentence, before the punctuation mark.

Appendix/Catalogue

References

Summary

Captions Plates, plans, figures, drawings, photos

They are all considered to be “fig” (from ‘figure’). Each figure must be attached to the manuscript in a separate file and numbered consecutively with Arabic numerals (i.e., **01fig.tif**, **02fig.tif**).

Suggested formats: *.TIFF, 600 dpi (grayscale), 300–600 dpi (colour)

Sizes: 80 mm or 164 mm width and may not exceed 216 mm in height. Smaller figures should be arranged on plates.

TABLES

They are all considered to be “Table”. Please take the size of the page into account when compiling the table.

NOTES

Footnotes should be used. All references of the footnotes are abbreviated. E.g. NOVÁKI 1957, 262–265.

REFERENCES

The list must contain all the abbreviated references of the footnotes in alphabetical order.

Please note that authors are urged to check their proofs carefully before submitting corrections, since late corrections cannot be guaranteed for inclusion and post-publication corrections are only possible in an erratum. Corrections to the proofs must be restricted to existing errors and adding minor updates. Rewriting the text or modifying authorship is not accepted in the proof stage.
