

# NOTES FOR CONTRIBUTORS

Only original papers will be published and a copy of the License Agreement will be sent to the authors of papers accepted for publication. Manuscripts will be processed only after receiving the signed copy of the agreement.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

A new online manuscript submission system called Open Journals System (OJS) has been introduced for the submission of manuscripts to *Acta Phytopathologica et Entomologica Hungarica*. Manuscripts should be submitted through the system at the following link: <https://submit.akademiai.com/aphyt/index.php/aphyt>

Manuscripts in English including Abstract, Literature, Tables and Captions should be typed double-spaced (25 lines, 50 characters per line including spaces) and supplied with authors' names, page number. Tables should be on separate, numbered pages after the Literature. Captions, on a separate page, should follow the tables.

## FORMAT

<i>Title</i>	The title should reflect the most important aspects of the article, in a preferably concise form of not more than 100 characters and spaces.
<i>By-line</i>	The authors' names should be followed by affiliations and addresses. (No inclusion of scientific titles is necessary.)
<i>Abstracts</i>	are required for all the manuscripts. They should be typed in one paragraph and limited to max. 200 words.
<i>Keywords</i>	Most important words of paper.
<i>Text</i>	Major sections after the introductory statements are: Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Literature. Subheadings may be used, though the unnecessary fragmentation of the text should be omitted.

- Figures* Line-drawing should be clear and of high quality. Cite all figures in numerical order in the manuscript. Captions should describe the contents so that each illustration is understandable when considered apart from the text. Each illustration should be labelled with the figure number, author's name, and *Acta Phytopathologica*.  
High-quality glossy prints of photographs should be cropped at right angles to show only essential details. Insert a scale bar where necessary to indicate magnification. Submit two sets of prints of equivalent quality.
- Tables* The title should be self-explanatory and include enough information so that each table is intelligible without reference to the text or other tables. The title should summarize the information presented in the table without repeating the subheadings. Subheadings should be brief (abbreviations are acceptable), nonstandard ones can be explained in footnotes. Cite tables in numerical order in the manuscript. Information presented in a table should agree with that in the text.
- Literature* List literature cited in alphabetic order by authors' surnames. The list should contain names and initials of all the authors (et al. is not accepted here); for journal articles year of publication, the title of the paper, title of the journal abbreviated (do not abbreviate one word titles), volume number, first and last page. Hungarian titles should be translated in parentheses.  
For books or chapters of books, the titles are followed by the publisher as well as place and date of publication.

- Offprints* Authors are also entitled to order offprint copies of their paper for a deep discounted price. See the official pricelist for details ([http://akademiai.hu/195/journals/for\\_authors/offprints](http://akademiai.hu/195/journals/for_authors/offprints)). Authors may order a minimum of 20 copies (the amount must be an even number), and the discount is 50%. The fee of pre-ordered offprints is even lower by 15%.
- Open Access* Authors can use the Optional Open Access publication model for a specific publishing fee. It is an option for the author to pay the Article Processing Charge (APC) and have the final full text version of his/her article published as an Open Access one. The full text of an Open Access paper is freely accessible through the official website of the journal. These papers are also published in the printed journals as well as all the traditional ones. The peer review process and the quality requirements are the same in case of both traditional and Open Access manuscripts. Both accepted new manuscripts and papers published earlier can be Open Access. The APC of an Open Access article is **749 EUR (including VAT)** but it can be even less. Akadémiai Kiadó offers discounts for Hungarian authors, institutions of low- and middle-income countries and Editorial Board members. Discounts may not be combined. The above fee does not include any normal (excess) page fees and colour charges. By signing the Open Access Licence Agreement and paying the APC, the Author retains the ownership and further rights related to the Article while ensuring the wide accessibility of the Article in the written and electronic media controlled by Akadémiai Kiadó.
